Installation Process

1. Download the application package from the provided URL
2. Navigate to the download directory and run the file setup_extra360.exe

Important: During the installation, a warning message from your browser or your operating system may appear. You can safely ignore it and proceed with the installation of the program.

We understand that downloading software can sometimes trigger warnings from Chrome (Download Restricted) and Windows Microsoft Defender (SmartScreen). - **For Chrome:** When you see the "Download Restricted" message, click on the arrow next to it, then select "Keep" allowing the download to continue.
- **For Windows Microsoft Defender (SmartScreen):** After the download completes, you might see a warning about the app being unrecognized. Click on "More info," then select "Run anyway" to install the software.

First Launch

The program initially defaults to Game 6/49 (Lotto 6/49), and you can load another system as needed from the "Open" menu.

This way, the settings will be loaded each time. However, it is recommended to write them down or take a screenshot of them somewhere else, in case you delete the saved file

- Select a previously saved setup to load configurations quickly.

Chapter 9: Printing on Play-Slips

Setting Up Printing

The print functionality has been designed with flexibility in mind to accommodate as many games as possible. However, considering the hundreds (or even thousands) of different game variations worldwide, including variations within the same country by geographic region with different betting slips for the same game, it is understandable that it is impossible to easily design any slip with all its peculiarities, despite the flexibility we have incorporated into the program. Additionally, the wide variety of printers available on the market (each with specific requirements and compatibilities) adds to the complexity.

Therefore, in some cases, you may need to compromise with the lack of convenience in printing additional numbers (e.g., jackpot, joker, golden number, +1, etc.) or write some special marks by hand (which vary by game, country, state, etc.), such as multipliers, consecutive draws, etc.

This is why the print functionality is provided as a bonus, free within the program, and it is not guaranteed to produce anything that one might imagine or desire. We welcome your suggestions and will evolve this capability in future versions of the program, but there is no guarantee for printing every special requirement. The printing capability is provided as-is and as a bonus, rather than being excluded from the program from the start. Thank you for your understanding on this matter.

Printing Settings

Setting up printing on slips initially can be very detailed and time-consuming. Don't get discouraged! Proceed step by step. First, roughly estimate the distances, then print a slip. After that, make fine adjustments and print another slip. For this purpose, we recommend creating (and saving) a small system with two or three combinations so that you print only one card each time before making the next fine adjustment. It might take dozens of prints to get the configuration right!

- The "X" setting represents the horizontal distance in pixels, while the "Y" setting represents the corresponding vertical distances.
- The "X for numbers" setting refers to the horizontal pixels for the numbers (the number boxes).
- The "Set" refers to the entire number grid of the game (e.g., 45 numbers). From the settings in the top left, you set how many numbers per row are in each set and how many such sets are in each slip horizontally and vertically.

- The other print settings (bottom left) determine the dimensions of the slip, horizontally and vertically, as well as the X, Y point from which printing will start (i.e., the box of number 1 in the first set of numbers on the slip).
- The "Y for Extra Numbers" setting defines the vertical (Y) distance of the extra number grids of the game (e.g., 1-20) from the main numbers of the slip (e.g., for the jackpot number, joker, golden number, etc.).
- The next box sets the active printer resolution in DPI (consult your printer manual or supplier).
- Finally, in the last input box, choose the character you want to print on the slips. If you change it and later wish to revert to the default, press the ALT key and type 219 in the box.
